When there is no activity such as workshops, trainings, etc., the GYTTE staff takes care of all the work and repairs required for the proper functioning of the "Tree of Life" center, such as: construction and repair projects, goat pastoring, births and care; clearing out brush and weeds after the rainy season and storms, trimming trees & bushes, lots of watering in the 6 months of dry season; making different kinds of compost, preparing materials for workshops, making goat cheese to sell, egg production to sell, Flor de Jamaica to sell, raising corn and cleaning Jamaica from June to October, square gardens, building gaviones and more.
