Project 1:
 Furrow Irrigation System to water our fields turning our land into crops to become more self-sustainable while providing food to villagers at a subsidized cost.
 Project cost: \$25,000.00





Project 2:
 Within our livestock options integrate aquaculture at our farm at a small scale to make it available to the locals as a means to improve their diet and as an option for locals to generate income.
 Project cost: \$15,300.00

Project 3:
 There are impoverished indigenous families in need of a home: \$8,000 per home.
